PLEASE NOTE:

Open every day from May 2nd thru October 25th. Reservations are required on weekdays with 24 hour notice, weekend reservations are suggested but not required.

New for 2020- plan your trip with an overnight camping stop right at our location. Tent sites with fire ring and potties on site for \$12.00 per person. Located adjacent to our shop so your equipment is safe and secure and only 200 yards from the river access. You can leave your vehicle at our shop with your belongings so you don't have to paddle on the river with your overnight equipment and food. With a convenience store within walking distance supplying food and items you may have forgotten this makes a great stay for the entire family.

May 2nd- Kayaking 101 with Art Coolbaugh. We will launch from the Falls park and learn to paddle up and down stream, learn how to enter and exit your craft, paddling secrets for a strong headwind and how to avoid obstacles in the water. What to do if your craft capsizes and learn how to read the moving water and plan your own trip. Cost is \$25.00 and includes all equipment, transportation. Reservations are required and lesson begins at 11:00am.

May 3rd- University of Scranton's sustainability club spring float. This is a private trip dedicated to the University's club traveling from West Falls to Appletree boat launch.

May 3rd- Eagle watch float from Whites Ferry to West Falls. Our nesting pair of eagles and their eaglets can be viewed from atop your craft without disturbing them in their natural beauty. Meet at the shop at 10:30am and our trip will be complete by 1:00 pm. Cost is \$45.00/single \$65.00/double or canoe and \$20 to bring your own.

Meet at our shop at 7:30 where we will transport you to the launch site and return to a riverside bonfire when we exit.
