USER AGREEMENT

I, _____, the undersigned, hereby release, hold harmless, and indemnify Susquehanna Kayak and Canoe Rental, its employees, agents and subcontractors, hereinafter SKCR, from any and all liability associated with the rental and use of any kayak or canoe. There are inherent risks in operating a kayak or canoe that could lead to serious or permanent injury, and I indemnify and hold SKCR harmless from any injury that befalls me. I acknowledge that I am adequately proficient and skilled in the use and safety of any kayak or canoe and that I will not operate the kayak or canoe in a manner that is potentially harmful to myself or any passengers. Furthermore, I will not operate the kayak or canoe in a manner that is detrimental to other users of the waterways and surrounding property. I will respect all laws regarding the use and maintenance of waterways and will hold SKCR harmless from any fines or summons that I may receive regarding my operation of any kayak or canoe on the waterways. I also acknowledge that I have a valid Pennsylvania fishing license if I intend to fish while using the kayak or canoe, and that I will follow all laws and regulations regarding wildlife and fishing in Pennsylvania.

I acknowledge that all waterways, in particular the Susquehanna River, are governed by the laws of nature and that SKCR makes no warranties, guarantees or assumptions about the use and conditions of said waterways. I indemnify and hold SKCR harmless for any injuries and damages that may occur to me or anyone else due to the condition of the waterways. If a force of nature or manmade condition makes the operation of a kayak or canoe unsafe to operate on a waterway I will immediately remove the kayak or canoe from the waterway and find a safe haven. SKCR also makes no warranties, guarantees or assumptions about the use of campsites during multi-day kayak and canoe trips. I acknowledge that all camping is done at my own risk, and that I will follow all rules and regulations applicable to any campsites. Furthermore, I will only camp in areas designated for camping.

I will not operate any kayak or canoe under the influence of alcohol or drugs, and indemnify and hold SKCR harmless from any actions that may occur from my operation of a kayak or canoe under the influence of alcohol or drugs. I will wear a personal flotation device at all times when operating any kayak, canoe or while swimming. I further acknowledge that I am able to swim, and that I indemnify and hold SKCR harmless for any injuries that may occur to me while swimming. I also acknowledge that I am in the appropriate physical condition to operate a kayak or canoe, and that I do not have any condition or infirmities that at any time will hinder my operation of a kayak or canoe.

I will return all equipment to SKCR in the condition that I received it except for normal wear and tear, and I acknowledge that all equipment that I receive is in adequate condition for the purpose of which it is intended. I will reimburse SKCR for any damages to the equipment that may result from inappropriate use while under my care. Furthermore, all rented equipment must be returned within a reasonable period of time. If equipment is not returned within a reasonable period of time, SKCR has the right at its own discretion to charge a late fee or additional rental fees. Also, SKCR is not responsible for the damage or loss of any personal property that may occur during the rental of a kayak or canoe. If I am under the age of 18 the below signatory is my legal guardian or has been appointed by my legal guardian to sign this waiver on my behalf.

ORIENTATION AND INTRODUCTION

The Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission requires that all participants become orientated with the laws and regulations applicable to kayaks, canoes and boating safety and that they become orientated with the conditions of the river. I acknowledge that I have been instructed on entry and exiting, paddling, body positioning, and to be aware of surroundings, rocks, trees, rapids, motorboats, and other potential impediments. This orientation is a short teaching technique to make people aware of situations they will encounter on their trip and to safely maximize the enjoyment of the outdoors.
